- New auditorium to replace 1956 auditorium
- Library renovation



Ag Science Barn

- Animal pens
- Classroom & lab



Traffic Relief, CTE Classroom Addition & Renovations at AMS

- · New traffic circulation drive
- New CTE construction classroom
- Natural grass field for outdoor class use
- New flooring in large gym
- · New bleachers in both gyms



Covered Activity Center

PURSUANT TO SECTION 45.003, TEXAS EDUCATION CODE

State law requires all school district bond election ballots to be printed with: "This is a property tax increase." The Athens ISD bond election does not come attached to an increase in your AISD property tax rate.

Athens ISD's debt tax rate will not increase if this bond proposal is approved by voters.
